#### **OUT OF STADIA PROGRAM 2025**

Details will be on the QMA website soon, but here is a summary: **ROAD CHAMPIONSHIPS** 

**10 km Championships** will once again be held in conjunction with the BRRC event on  $22^{nd}$  June.

**The QMA Half Marathon Challenge** will follow the same format as previous years. Run one or more half marathon events between 1 April and 31 October to be eligible to enter.

#### **Out of Stadia continued**

**QMA Marathon Championships** will be held with the Gold Coast Marathon Festival. Enter the QMA championship event when you enter the GC Marathon.

#### **CROSS COUNTRY**

QMA members are eligible to enter all QA cross country events and championships. Details of all events are on the QA website **HERE**.

The Short Course Cross Country Championships including Masters events will be held at Nudgee on Saturday 10<sup>th</sup> May and the Long Course at Toogoolawah on Saturday 12<sup>th</sup> July.
